CRAFTSBURY CONSERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES

December 20, 2021 Called to order at 7:00 p.m., Craftsbury Town Hall

AGENDA ADDITIONS: Farley: municipal planning grant; Susie: Town Meeting update.

NEW COMMISSIONERS: Steve welcomed Liz Keglor and Colin Netzley to the Conservation Commission and asked them to join working group(s) that interest them.

LIST OF NATURAL RESOURCES WEB SITES: June reviewed the attached list of websites for inclusion on the Conservation Commission's page of the Town website. Diane moved to accept June's list, with the additions of Vermont Center for Ecostudies and the Vermont Woodlands Association. Brian seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

ASH TREE INVENTORY REPORT TO SELECTBOARD: Brian and Rob Libby presented the draft plan to the Selectboard on October 26, 2021. The Selectboard approved the creation of an *ad hoc* Committee to perform the inventory. Given the absence of EAB in Craftsbury and nearby towns, Brian and Rob will survey other towns for possible inventory approaches and pilot several approaches in 2022 before performing a fuller inventory in 2023. Presentation posted with Selectboard minutes.

MUNICIPAL PLANNING GRANT: Craftsbury received a \$22,000 municipal planning grant, which the Town is matching with \$4,000 from the Good Neighbor Fund, to create a Master Plan. The Planning Commission will present its recommendations to the Selectboard in February 2023.

TOWN MEETING REPORT: Steve and Brian will draft and circulate for comments. Deadline is January 14, 2022.

WORKING GROUP REPORTS

- Conservation Fund: Farley and Diane began drafting a flyer for Town Meeting and for posting at local gathering spots. Susie noted that approval of money for the Conservation Fund may be more difficult because this is the final year of the Good Neighbor Fund. Diane moved that the Conservation Commission request the Selectboard to warn a Town Meeting article requesting \$7,000 from the Good Neighbor Fund for the Craftsbury Conservation Fund. June seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
- Invasives: Elinor has asked a botanist for help identifying the "Jerusalem Artichoke" found at the Japanese Knotweed demonstration plot last summer. If it is indeed Jerusalem Artichoke, Fish & Wildlife recommend that we control it, even though it may be a native species.

NEXT MEETING: The Commission will meet on January 17, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in Town Hall. Proposed agenda to include: reaffirm Conservation Fund warning vote; approve October and December 2021 meeting minutes; review Conservation Fund flyer; Kingdom Community Wind update.

Farley moved to adjourn at 8:13pm. Brian seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
