- APPROVE MINUTES Minutes were approved with a couple errors Michelle will correct.
- UPDATE- HARDWICK MOVEMENT Monique gave an update of the Hardwick movement. Their original senior center location doesn't have wi-fi, so they are now considering the leased NEK for therapists, a yellow building in Hardwick. Josh Burke is working on the project with the Town Manager and Police Department.
- UPDATE-MINDFULNESS CLASS, NANCY Nancy loves the new mindfulness class, learning so much. She hopes to share with the community later next year.
- UPDATE-CRAFTSBURY SUICIDE AWARENESS WALK Michelle reported the walk raised \$3434.48, with \$250 for AFSP, \$100 for NAMI, and rest for the Craftsbury Mental Health Resource Group. The Craftsbury Mental Health Funs has over \$14,000 now.
- UPDATE ARPA FUNDS, WILL NEED SUBGROUP RESEARCH BOOKS AND MAYBE OFFER PAYMENT OF THE \$39 LIVING WORKS PROGRAMS FOR ANY ONE IN CRAFTSBURY WHO IS INTERESTED. The Craftsbury Mental Health Committee had asked for \$2,00 and was awarded \$5,000.

Michelle suggested a book subgroup, to help decide which books to purchase with the grant. Nancy, Lisa-Anne, Lise and Michelle agreed to be a sub group for choosing the books. We will also look into digital resources, ask for input from Sally Guebara. Michelle has a list already from the School librarian.

The Committee agreed to offer the \$39 Living Works program to the community, and reimburse all that are interested with the ARPA funds. Michelle will put a blurb out on FPF.
