## SELECT BOARD AGENDA

- Action Jim Jones called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.
- Action Adjustments/Changes to Agenda add ARPA Request: School Booster Club
- Action Approve Selectboard Minutes (three separate meeting minutes)
  - March 7 Town Meeting Minutes Bruce Urie motioned to approve the town meeting minutes;
    Susan seconded. All ayed. Motion passed.
  - March 17 Special Select Board Meeting with Steve Marckres and Eric Pope Bruce motioned to approve the minutes of the March 17 Special Meeting; Susan seconded. All ayed. Motion passed.
  - February 28 Regular Selectboard meeting minutes. Bruce motioned to approve the minutes; Susan seconded. Discussion – corrections and adjustments to reflect accuracy. VCDP has not pre-approved the additional grant money; must be applied for – decision is pending. Changes made. No further discussion. All ayed. Motion passed.
- Action ARPA Funds Request: Craftsbury School Booster Club Members April Royan and Joey LaMare presented information regarding the following:
  - Concession stand \$4,500
  - Batting cage (Craftsbury Academy gym location) \$3181.06
  - Shooting machine \$5490 (\$4995 w/out tax, etc.)
    - <u>\$13,171.06</u> total request

Jim motioned to approve the request for \$13,171.06 for the three items – noting that payment/check for the batting cage must be to Mark Royan; the batting cage was pre-paid by Mr. Royan; Bruce seconded. All ayed. Motion passed.

- Discussion Childcare for Town Meeting
- Action Pay for Lead Lister: discussion. Susan motioned to increase the Lead Lister pay hourly wage to \$30; Bruce seconded. All ayed. Motion passed.
- Action Approve Select Board Chair: been approved. Susan motioned to appoint Bruce and Jim as Selectboard co-chairs; Bruce seconded. All ayed. Motion passed.
- Action Appoint committee members: Susan listed the committee recommendations:

- *Conservation Commission* has two people who responded and signed up as possibilities at Town Meeting: filling two full-time positions for four years. No appointments at this point.
- Energy Committee two leaving and two are staying on; one recommendation Ian Nelson to start for a three-year term. Susan motioned to appoint Ian Nelson to the Energy Committee; Jim seconded. All ayed. Motioned passed.
- *Neighbor-to-Neighbor* both agreed to do another term (Two up for term limits: Kris Coville and Tim Fritz).
- *Recreation Committee* a number of people termed out.
- Website Committee Susan motioned to appoint Victoria Hudson to the Website Committee; Jim seconded. All ayed. Motion passed.
- *Mental Health Resource Group* just wanted to add people to the group. Three total added.
- *ARPA Working Group* work concluded; group disbanded.
- Antiques & Uniques a working group.
- Forestry Committee three more years for those already on.
- Town Service Officer Susan motioned to appoint Michelle Warren as Town Service Officer; Bruce seconded. All ayed. Motion passed.
- *WWII Memorial Trustees & Craftsbury War Memorial Committee* letters to be sent to potential candidates.
- *NEK CUD* membership remains the same.
