Action – Approve Select Board Regular Meeting Minutes of May 2, 2023

Susan Houston motioned to approve minutes of the May 2 regular meeting; Bruce Urie seconded. All ayed. Motion passed.

Discussion – Energy Committee (Ned Houston)

Discussion of Solar-Savings process; billing. The Energy Committee is pleased with credit information; must view more than just solar credit. Perhaps an annual accounting; data could show costs with/without solar number of KWh. Hydroelectric and State changed some calculations re: Efficiency Vermont write-offs. No longer can have a zero bill; probably last time Town will see a \$0 billing from Hardwick Electric Generating about two-thirds of what we use; \$2500 a year going forward. Energy Committee encouraged by that. Garage and Town Hall use a fair amount of electricity. Doesn't vary much over the years; winters are surprisingly not that much. Different. September seems to be the best month: not cold and not trying to take care of trucks. Encouraging and pleased; will continue additional conservation efforts. Good concrete numbers.

• Discussion – Solid Waste Update

Solid waste district update; at meeting this month. Rate hike going into effect July 1 (\$1/bag). Still lower than all the other facilities. Waiting to post on FPF.

Haven't made forward movement on pending items. Will get in motion within next few months. Can't recall any that were time-sensitive. Received notice that State has approved/accepted the Town LEMP – Local Emergency Management Plan. State reviewed it. Next year will be more organized.
