Action – Adjustments / Changes to Agenda

Adjustments to topic order: addition of Window Dressers and Young Road topics.

- Action Approve Select Board Regular Meeting Minutes of May 16, 2023.
 - Susie Houston motioned to approve the meeting minutes; Bruce Urie seconded. No further discussion. Motion passed.
- Discussion Window Dressers Estimate for Windows at Town Hall Kevin Gregoire
 Total \$247.68 for the five windows | waiting for painter estimate. Bruce motioned to approve the work at the estimated cost; Susan seconded. No further discussion. All ayed. Motion passed. The Select Board thanked Mr. Gregoire for all his work and efforts.
- Discussion Village Improvement Society Harry Miller

Signage and lighting idea; Harry Miller wanted to be here to discuss but was unavailable. Possible to build a staging on the west side under trees. Will keep gazebo, do roof. Staging area discussed.

Discussion – Delinquent Tax Policy & Payment Agreement - Alison Blaney

Delinquent Tax Collector Alison Blaney stated indications are good for knowing where Craftsbury stands in terms of what has been received/owed. Ms. Blaney presented the Delinquent Tax Policy and Payment Agreement for Select Board review and approval; perhaps it should go out with every bill; or post on website with notice. Select Board must make announcement about policy also. The agreement is between the property owner and town representative/delinquent tax collector. Susan motioned to approve the Delinquent Tax Policy and Payment Agreement (agreement between tax collector and delinquent taxpayer); Bruce seconded. No further discussion. All ayed. Motion passed.

Discussion – Turn-Around Sign | Young Road – Jeannine Young

Try a stop sign at turn-around; dead-end and no place to turn around. Still, people will drive all the way down and turn around and use private drive. Demolish mailbox.

Discussion – Gravel for Craftsbury Public House

A few small tractor buckets.

Action – Auditor/Lister Rates

Difference in rates paid. Bruce motioned to approve the rate difference – to \$16/hour; Susan seconded it. No further discussion. All ayed. Motion passed.

Action – Dog Warrant

Reviewed draft list of dog owners with unregistered pets. Bruce motioned to serve the dog warrants to those on the list; Susan seconded. All ayed. Motion passed.

• Discussion – Historic Window – Jeff Fellinger

Will obtain other input; paint repair can hold off until further input received.

• Discussion – CCC Sign for Demonstration Site

\$250; new sign to put up. Should come out of committee budget line.

Discussion – Radar Signs

Mail and send in. Susie will handle.

Must have record-keeping (free inserts: donations \$3500; have a grant in NE Grass Roots Environmental Fund probably get \$2500. Also other monies from elsewhere.) Grant monies will pay for most of the inserts; in Town Office; five in office.
- Conservation Commission first BioBlitz training was good; 10 people came. Very interested. Will do another training; exciting potential to have a town-wide nature inventory. Very beneficial for town. Elinor Osborn has taken on this project.
