# Craftsbury Municipal Forest Committee Meeting Minutes February 9, 2023, 6:30 pm, Town Hall

## Black River Tree Planting

Stuart and Jim J. have contacted several landowners with land along the Black River between the Cemetery Road and the Albany town line.

- Some landowners were uninterested in any tree planting on their land.
- Others were opposed to any long-term contract commitments or government funding.
   Most federally-funded programs do require a commitment to maintain planted buffers for
   some period of time from 1 to 30 years. However, not all state-funded programs carry this
   requirement, so we may be able to work with individual land-owners to find programs that
   fit their needs.
- Committee members suggested contacting the owner of the land north of the Black River Road on the east bank of the river. Stuart will reach out to him.

The sense of the committee is that we should not use the funds from previous town forest harvests to purchase trees for planting on private land. Logan will investigate private funding sources, such as through Ducks Unlimited or Trout Unlimited. He thought we would have no trouble recruiting volunteers to help plant.

Barbara suggested starting with a pilot program of just a few trees on the sites with most potential, to see how well they do.

Ann will respond to Sarah Damsell of the Orleans Natural Resources Conservation District to:

- Let her know that we are still working on landowner outreach;
- Ask what programs if any require no long-term landowner commitment; and
- Convey our interest in a small trial planting if she ever has surplus trees.

## **Town Forest Signs**

Ann has 10 signs available. In May, Logan will help locate the boundaries using GPS and any others interested can join to post the signs. We'll set a date during our next meeting.
