- Craftsbury Town Solar
 - Offsite Array possibility put on hold until we revisit Town Garage Roofs.
 - Kevin and Ned will ask the Select Board to hire a Structural Engineer to get an analysis of the smaller shed roofs at the Town Garage

- Tour of Energy Efficient Homes -
 - Late Summer / Fall possibility

- Town Hall Basement Weatherization
 - Kevin will get Select Board Approval of supply price increase
 - Removal of plywood walls and fiberglass insulation timing
 - Kevin will organize site visit needed with Select Board to assess Clerk's Office crawl space

- Firewood Project
 - Kevin will organize another Firewood Processing Bee with the GRP athletes once we get more firewood delivered
 - Ideas on recruiting more volunteers to help process wood:
 - Serve donated "Fred's Famous Ice Cream from Ben and Jerry's.
 - "Touch a Truck" - Collaborate with the Fire Dept. to give rides to Kids while we are processing firewood.

- Microgrid for the Library
 - Ned shared that funds are a challenge for the Library to go ahead

with a large install. He will look into the possibility of just a large battery to meet the Library's needs first and add solar later.
