- Original Battery is working, despite basement flooding. With concern that it was non-operable, funding arrived to buy a 2nd battery the same size 9 kWh. Now we have two batteries!
- Web site is now online to allow the Public to view energy production
- 30 percent rebate from the Fed. Govt.- Ned
