Minutes January 16, 2020 Craftsbury Energy Committee

- 1. Town Report 2019 Article was finished, shared and sent to the Town Auditors
- 2. Town Comprehensive Energy Plan is to be approved by the Select Board.
- 3. Town Hall weatherization project
 - Discussion around asking for some of the Green Mtn. Power "Good neighbor fund' which will mean waiting until after Town Meeting or doing it now
 - Kevin will look at the cost of materials and submit a proposal to the Select Board to do the work now. He thinks it may cost around \$500.
- 4. Window Insert Project 2020
 - Do workshop after Oct. 15th at the Craftsbury Outdoor Center (COC)
 - Need to make a minimum of 225 (which can combine with Greensboro and maybe Westmore)
 - The Maine WindowDressers.org want to pair Westmore or Westfield with us as they wouldn't have enough people on their own
 - Glover will do their workshop with Sutton
 - Kevin has a couple of inserts to use as a demo
 - Need to do publicity
 - Measurements are needed 7 to 10 days before the materials are picked up
 - Discussion on how to select families that need/want the inserts
 - Low-income families can qualify for 10 free inserts
 - Prioritize low-income. If people drop out, then others can get more than 10
 - 3 ft by 3 ft costa \$35-\$40 dollars. Need to get 2020 pricing
 - In 2019 Efficiency VT (EVT) gave rebates. Kevin will look into whether there will be rebates from EVT in 2020
 - Paula Davison (the new Library Director at the Greensboro Library) and her husband, Matt Moody have noted that the library is a good candidate for inserts. She will bring it to their Board of Trustees. It would be a great place for advertising to the public. The comfort and costsavings can be tracked.
 - Everyone felt that we should get as many people signed up and measured in the winter/early spring and as for half the cost as a deposit. Then do another round of sign-ups in early September
 - Advertise this spring and a Town Meeting
 - Advertise benefits for low-income families and that there will be a sliding scale. Molly Brandt from Greensboro has set up a good scale. Kevin will contact her
 - Energize VT gave grant money in 2019. Will they do this again. Kevin will explore this
 - Thetford got grants from local banks and the New England Grassroots Environmental Fund. Lisa will look into this.
 - Need to get testimonials from people who got them in 2019. Margie Ramsdell would be good. Hannah and Mabel will go interview her and get photos.
 - Kevin and Paula will work on an article for the Craftsbury Gazette section of the Hardwick Gazette.

- Need to set up dates for taking measurements, not just random times
