- Get testimonials from households that got inserts about their effectiveness
- Cost: figure out a sliding scale
- When measuring at a house make a judgement about the household's ability to pay
- Find grant money to help low-income people afford them
- Advertise that there is a sliding scale
- Anna will get Molly's wording as she had a good way of explaining the pricing
- Solicit donations which could go to the local energy committee to help low-income people or to Window Dressers in Maine
- Get some of our own equipment? Where would it be housed?
- Energize Vermont helped with paying for some low income people in Greensboro
- Jack said he has the carpenters' jigs
- When to start finding people who want to have them? Spring (April) or fall? Both times?
- Go to the Food Pantry to advertise and find low income people
