<u>Booklet</u> – Michelle has sent out 'assignments' for folks – asking them to seek information for a certain section of the booklet – for updating. Everyone is making their calls. - We agreed that folks with social anxiety may struggle getting back into social and other situations involving in-person gathering. We also agreed there is and will continue to be fear of COVID-19.
- We suggested using Front Porch Forum for publishing articles and suggestions for coping with fear/discomfort.
- Kim called the group's attention to two articles. The group agreed to check with other on-line sites for helpful resources.

Current COVID Status

The group discussed current status of folks, particularly young adults. Many seem to have lost their sense of hope.

Shall we remain a Town Committee

The group discussed the pros/cons of remaining a town committee. We agreed the pros outweigh the cons:

- It gives us good visibility and legitimacy
- It provides a good vehicle for handling Wesley's Fund

The agenda needs to be posted 2-3 days ahead of the meeting, and the minutes need to be posted within 5 business days of the meeting.

<u>Craftsbury Academy – NAMI presentation</u>

Michelle reported a conversation with Sally. The NAMI presentation prompted much needed conversation. Michelle will continue to reach out to the school to remind them of our group and see how we can help/support.

Our next meeting will be Thursday, May 13, 6pm. We may meet in person. As the date nears, we'll check the state guidelines. We would meet in the dining room/fellowship hall of the Church on the Common.
