# • Vendor Updates- Michelle

The Committee approved 4 new vendors- Mamma Karma's, Kingdom Kreperie, 3SX 3D Printing and Tinks Treasures. Right now we have 29 vendors, with 2 vendors having 2 sites.

We looked over the new welcome vendor sample image, we decided on the dark green one.

For the postcard, Michelle will add QR code and Shuttle Bus available and put a yellow button for the URL. She found a less expensive post card source for just \$86, Bruce suggested looking into Vista Print too.

For the Kingdom Guide business card ad, will put the QR code instead of the right pix... will also use less words.. will have draft ready for the next meeting.

Lise and Michelle will work on the press release and send out to potential vendors.

#### • Food Vendors- Lise

Woodbelly Pizza is signed up along with Kingdom Kreperie. Michelle thinks CVillage is still on board. Lise will check with Front Seat Coffee. Bruce said he had spoken to a potential food vendor, Red Hot BBQ, asked them to check out the website.

## • Communication & Advertising- Michelle

The new Jotform has worked great for vendor communication. Michelle has pared down the print and radio ads to half on the budget, just one week of ads instead of two. We will put more money into Facebook ads.

## Budget- Michelle

Michelle handed the committee a revised budget. With the addition of the VT Council Ad of \$1800, and reduced advertising, we are hoping to have enough to pay for larger expenditures such as nicer umbrellas and garbage/recycle bins

## • **Grants/Sponsors/Fundraisers**- Michelle & Lise

Michelle said the VT Tourism sponsorship isn't online yet. Michelle can try to do the VEC grant. We can check with Susie if she can help with the Community Grant, Lisa is also looking in several options of the community grant plus another one online.
